- 1.1 In this Business Plan Commitment, "Minor Works Programmes" means schemes to introduce additional facilities at stations to improve accessibility for disabled persons and those with additional needs.
- 1.2 The Operator shall, by no later than 29 February 2024 and subject to the approval from the Secretary of State, deliver Minor Works Programmes.
- 1.3 The Operator shall not less than Quarterly, report on actions in relation to the delivery of Minor Works and the expenditure actually incurred in relation to such actions.
- 1.4 The Operator shall, in carrying out its obligations under paragraph 1.2, incur a maximum spend which does not exceed [REDACTED<sup>1</sup>]

#### 2. Speech to Text Functionality; Roll out to cl397 ACC3-002

- 2.1 The Operator shall by no later than 29 February 2024, subject to the Secretary of State's approval of the fleet-wide enabling software and hardware upgrade to the PA system within the existing lease and maintenance contracts and the successful trial of speech to text functionality on Cl397 in 22/23 Business Plan Year, implement speech to text functionality on its Cl397 fleet of twelve trains.

- 13.2 The Operator shall, by no later than 28 April 2023, produce and issue to the Secretary of State a report setting out how the introduction of Wi-Fi Traffic Shaping could be operationalised by 25 August 2023 or such later date as may be agreed by the Secretary of State, which shall include:
  - 1. consideration of the introduction of W-Fi Traffic Shaping across the TPE fleets; and 2.
  - the costs which would be incurred in introducing Wi-Fi Traffic Shaping; and
  - 3. the benefits to be realised in introducing Wi-Fi Traffic Shaping.

## 14. Proposal on Tickets and Claims - Delay Repay CEX3-011

- 14.1 The Operator shall, using reasonable endeavours to do so by 12 October 2023 and, in any event by no later than 29 February 2024, produce and issue to the Secretary of State for approval a costed proposal to increase the range of tickets and circumstances in which the claims process for passengers and processing of claims should be largely automated.
- 14.2 The Operator shall incur a maximum expenditure which does not exceed [REDACTED<sup>21</sup>] in implementing the costed proposal.

## 22. Fare reduction trials REV3-002

22.1 The Operator shall by no later than 29 June 2023, identify and issue to the Secretary of State for comment and approval, fare reductions for Season, Anytime and Off Peak fares to be implemented at the September 2023 fares round (or such earlier date as may be agreed with the Secretary of State and other affected Operators) on a trial basis in selected less economically developed areas of the TPE network.

## 23. Automatic Number Plate Recognition renewal and installation REV3-005

23.1 The Operator shall, by no later than 29 February 2024, install:

- 1. replacement car park automatic number plate recognition cameras at Huddersfield, Northallerton, Brough, Hull and Middlesbrough; and
- 2. an automatic number plate recognition system at Thornaby.
- 23.2 The Operator shall incur a maximum expenditure which does not exceed [REDACTED<sup>27</sup>] in delivering its obligations under paragraph 23.1.

## 24. Collaboration with Great British Rail REV3-006

24.1 The Operator shall collaborate with industry partners to support Great British Rail Sale activity to maximise the Operator's return from any such sales, as required during the 23/24 Business Plan Year. The Operator shall provide to the Secretary of State an update on any such collaboration by no later than 29 February 2024.

- 54.2 Subject to the Secretary of State approving the Cab Modifications Contract the Operator shall thereafter complete the delivery of the cab desk modifications in accordance with the timescales set out above and shall report to the Secretary of State, on a Quarterly basis, on actions in relation to the delivery of cab desk modifications and the expenditure actually incurred in relation to such actions.
- 54.3 The Operator shall incur a maximum expenditure which does not exceed [REDACTED<sup>43</sup>] in delivering the cab desk modifications in 23/24.
