JUDGMENT

- 1) The correct name of the Respondent is The Crown Pub Hawes Ltd (in voluntary liquidation)
- 2) The claimant's complaint of unlawful deduction from wages is well funded and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £1499.94.
- 3) The claimant's complaint of breach of the working time regulations (holiday pay) is also well founded and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £1915.30.
- 4) The claimant's complaint of a failure to provide itemised pay slips is not well founded and is hereby dismissed.

REASONS
