I would like to register my strong objections to the proposal to erect a marquee in the Garden of Promenade House.

- a) this will be a blight on the beautiful Clifton area and surroundings
- b) removal of trees is an unforgivable undertaking in any circumstances
- c) car parking in this area is already beyond capacity and can not cope with more cars.

[REDACTED] Percival Rd., Camp Rd., Norland Rd., are all now just extensions of the Stride Treglowan and EDF car parks.

The number of parking permits issued are already unreasonable; residents themselves are often unable to park within a close distance of the houses they own mon - fri.

As the parking restrictions currently end at 5.00 on a Friday, the weekend then becomes an extension of the Clifton Village parking scheme and is free of charge.

It's ridiculous and unacceptable and must be disallowed.
