JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's complaints of direct sex discrimination, pursuant to s.13 Equality Act 2010 are upheld.
- 2. The Respondent shall pay compensation to the Claimant for financial loss and injury to feelings of £91,597.82 which is calculated as follows:
 - a. Compensatory award for financial loss, inclusive of interest and grossing up, of £61,634.72.
 - b. Injury to feelings, inclusive of interest and grossing up, of £29,963.10.
- 3. The sums payable directly to the Claimant are now payable and must be made to the Claimant within 28 days of the date of this judgment.
