The documents are:

- a statement of the grounds of appeal
- a copy of any relevant application
- a copy of any relevant environmental permit
- a copy of any relevant correspondence between the appellant and the regulator
- a copy of any decision or notice which is the subject matter of the appeal and
- a statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or dealt with by way of written representations.
