JUDGMENT

The Claimant's claim is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. On 15th April 2024, Employment Judge Aspinall ordered the Claimant, by 22nd April 2024, to 'demonstrate and confirm that she has complied with Orders 67 73 of EJ Fowell's orders of 8 January 2024 and that she is in the process of complying with the remaining Orders too.'
- 2. Employment Judge Aspinall warned that, 'If the Claimant either a) does not respond to this instruction as directed; or b) has not, in fact, complied with the Orders as required, a Judge will consider whether to strike out her claim in its entirely under Rule 37 of The Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 (as amended).' (My emphasis).
- 3. The Claimant has failed to comply with the Orders made on 15th April 2022 and her claim is struck out under Rule 37(b), (c), and (d), and of The Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 (as amended) because the Claimant:
 - (i) Has behaved or conducted the litigation in a way which isunreasonable or vexatious.
 - (ii) Has failed to comply with an instruction or Order of the Tribunal.(iii) Has failed to actively pursue her claims.
- 4. The Final Hearing listed for, 14th to 17th May 2024 is vacated.
