## JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

## REASONS

1. By a letter dated 5 February 2024 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim should not be struck out because:
  - the claimant had not complied with Rule you have not complied with the Case Management Orders of the Tribunal dated 11 September 2023(in particular Part B paragraphs 36, 38 and 40)
  - it has not been actively pursued.
2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The claim is therefore struck out.
3. The hearing fixed for 4 – 6 September 2024 will not take place.
