We refer to your email dated 12 January 2024 to the Ministry of Defence Police (MDP), which was acknowledged on 12 January 2024.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

I would like to request under Freedom of Information the following information

1. How many crimes on the metaverse have been reported to your force since 2021?

By Metaverse, I mean a virtual-reality space in which users can interact within a computer-generated environment such as Meta's game Horizon Worlds. If possible please can you detail the nature of the offence alleged, time of the reporting and decision in the case whether to investigate or not.

A search for information has now been completed I can confirm that MDP does hold information in scope of your request.
