

**NOTICE OF HEARING
KNOWL MOOR COMMON**

Claire Tregembo, an inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs will hold a hearing at the Scout Hut behind St Paul's Parish Hall, Blackpitts Road, Norden, Rochdale, OL11 5NG on **25 June 2024** into an application by Norden, Bamford & Heywood Bridleways Association under Section 38 of the Commons Act 2006 for consent for works already in place on Knowl Moor Common.

The proposed works are a fence that runs parallel with the Edenfield Road to the north across the south width of the common with three 'steel kissing gate' access points and horse stiles to allow access to users of the common.

The hearing will begin at 10.00am on **25 June 2024**. Anyone can attend the hearing. Anyone who wishes to be heard on the subject matter of the application may, at the discretion of the inspector, give evidence at the hearing or arrange for someone to do so on their behalf.
