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Monthly Summary

- 1.1.1 This Summary Report is published in fulfilment of commitments detailed in the High Speed Rail (London-West Midlands) Environmental Minimum Requirements, Annex 1: Code of Construction Practice, for the nominated undertaker to present the results of air quality and dust monitoring undertaken in Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council (SMBC) during March 2024.
- 1.1.2 Figures 1 to Figure 3 in Appendix A present the current worksites together with the dust monitoring locations.
- 1.1.3 This summary should be read in conjunction with the overview monitoring report monthly available from www.gov.uk/government/collections/monitoring-the-environmental-effects-of-hs2, which highlights: the applicable standards and guidance, as well as the air quality and dust monitoring methodologies to be implemented by nominated undertakers throughout construction.
- 1.1.4 The current worksites, as presented in Appendix A, Figure 1 to Figure 3, include:

Sublot 2B2

Waste Lane Overbridge Satellite

- Galldris excavation works for Burton Green Tunnel; and
- Green Tunnel / Jet washing the tunnel walls.

Carol Green Rail Underbridge

- Lascombe Culvert works / Haul road diversion / Crane for culvert installation; and
- Wheel washer operating / deliveries.

Sublot 2B3

Balsall Common Viaduct

- Piling works by SB3;
- Haul road traffic; and
- Truggist Lane traffic.

Park Lane

- Material stockpile and reload / moving plant;
- M214 platform construction / rollers / diggers;
- Concrete works for M214 / haul road traffic; and
- Material stockpile and reload.

Sublot 5S

Coleshill Heath Road Underbridge


- Steel fixing;
- Demobilisation;
- Excavations;
- Hand trimming;
- Platform extension; and
- Pre-augering.




- · Rigid inclusions;
- Haul road maintenance; and
- Excavate, lay and duct.
- 1.1.5 Nine (9) dust monitors are installed around these worksites, where works are underway. These sites returned a low to medium dust risk rating.
- 1.1.6 Dust monitoring locations and results are presented in Appendix B, Table 1, together with line charts of monthly data from the dust monitors presented in Figure 4. All continuous dust monitoring is undertaken using indicative monitors. Despite being Environment Agency (MCERTS) certified, indicative monitors carry a higher level of uncertainty than reference monitors, and therefore cannot be strictly compared with Air Quality Standards for human health and the environment. The purpose of the monitoring undertaken is to ensure the effectiveness of the on-site mitigation.
- 1.1.7 The trigger level for PM_{10} concentrations of 190 µg/m³, over a 1-hour period, in accordance with the updated guidance document 'Guidance on Monitoring in the Vicinity of Demolition and Construction Sites (October 2018)' has been applied.
- 1.1.8 No (0) dust trigger alerts were recorded during the monitoring period (March 2024).
- 1.1.9 There were no (0) complaints received during this reporting period (March 2024).

Figures 1-3: Worksites and Monitoring Locations within SMBC




