JUDGMENT

The complaint that the claimant was unfairly dismissed is struck out.

CORRECTED REASONS

- 1. The claimant complains of unfair dismissal.
- 2. Until the date of his dismissal the claimant was a serving police officer
- 3. Section 200 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 excludes police officers from claiming the right not to be unfairly dismissed contained in section 98 of that Act.
- 4. The claimant has not asserted a claim falling within sections 100 or 103A of the Act
- 5. Therefore the claimant is not entitled to bring such a complaint.
- 6. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the complaint should not be struck out.
- 7. Accordingly, the complaint of unfair dismissal is struck out. The claimant's other complaints (if any) are not affected by this judgment.
