JUDGMENT

The claimant's application for reconsideration sent to the Tribunal on 18 April 2024 in respect of a Judgment sent to the parties on 14 February 2024 is refused, there being no reasonable prospects of the Judgment being varied or revoked.

REASONS

- 1. Rule 72 of Schedule 1 to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution & Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 provides that the Employment Judge shall consider any application to reconsider a Judgment.
