RECONSIDERATION DECISION

The Claimant's 2nd application for reconsideration of the Judgment sent to the parties on 18th March 2024 is refused on the grounds that it is misconceived.

The Claimant's 1st application for reconsideration was refused on the grounds that it had been submitted outside of the 14 day time limit.

In his 2nd application the Claimant invites the Tribunal to reconsider some of its findings of facts of its own motion. In considering it the Tribunal notes the objections raised by the Respondent in its email of 16th April 2024.
