

THE OFFSHORE COMBUSTION INSTALLATIONS (POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL) REGULATIONS 2013 (AS AMENDED) ("THE OFFSHORE (PPC) REGULATIONS 2013")

SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE

In accordance with the requirements of the Offshore Combustion Installations (Pollution Prevention and Control) Regulations 2013 (as amended), Shell UK Limited has applied to the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero for a permit to operate a combustion installation at the Penguins Floating Production Storage and Offloading (FPSO) Installation in Block 211/13, Reference PPC/113.

As required under regulation 5(3), the Secretary of State hereby gives notice of the additional information relevant to the application.
