**Respondent:** Suez Recycling and Recovery UK Limited

## JUDGMENT

The remaining complaints of detriment on the ground of having made protected disclosures that had not already been struck out following the hearing on 14<sup>th</sup> February 2024 are struck out.

## REASONS

1. Following a preliminary hearing on 14<sup>th</sup> February 2024 some of the claimant's complaints of detriment on the ground of having made protected disclosures were struck out as having no reasonable prospects of success. In respect of the remaining allegations of complaints of detriment on the ground of having made protected disclosures, the claimant was ordered to pay a deposit of £75.
2. The Order was sent to the claimant on **19<sup>th</sup> March 2024**. The claimant has failed to pay this deposit. The remaining complaints of detriment on the ground of having made protected disclosures are therefore struck out under rule 39(4) of the **Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013**.
3. The claimant's remaining complaints will proceed to a final hearing on 8<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> September 2025.
