Fluenz Tetra (AstraZeneca) LAIV (nasal)	Influenza	Eligible paediatric age groups*	
Boostrix-IPV (GSK) dTaP/IPV	Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis and polio	3 years 4 months	
Gardasil 9 (MSD) Human papillomavirus vaccine (HPV)	Cancers and genital warts caused by specific human papillomavirus (HPV) types	12 to 13 years (school Year 8)	
Revaxis (Sanofi) Td/IPV	Tetanus, diphtheria and polio	14 years (school Year 9)	
MenQuadfi (Sanofi) MenACWY	Meningococcal groups A, C, W and Y	14 years (school Year 9)	
ADACEL (Sanofi) Tdap	Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis	Pregnant women from 16 weeks gestation	
Pneumovax 23 (MSD) Pneumococcal Polysaccharide Vaccine (PPV23)	Pneumococcal (23 serotypes)	65 years (and certain at-risk groups)**	
Shingrix (GSK) Shingles	Shingles	From 1 September 2023 onwards: 50+ years and severely immunosuppressed; eligible age groups***; 70 years+ if Zostavax not available	
Zostavax (MSD) whilst supplies available Shingles	Shingles	70+ years of age (immunocompetent)***
