Thank you for your correspondence of 30 May 2023 in which you requested the following information:

'On the published change of command of the UK Carrier Strike Group, the Unit Social Media published an image of the outgoing commander being taken out in a Koenigsegg Regera, a rare Hypercar that costs in the region of £2,000,000. Only 80 were made.

Was any element of the provision of this car at public expense?

If so how was this justified and does this provision fall within the provisions of Defence procurement and accounting?'

Your enquiry has been considered to be a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

A search has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

In response to your request, I can confirm that no costs were incurred at public expense for [REDACTED] to be a passenger in this vehicle.
