## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: VEHICLE CRIME IN CAR PARKS

We refer to your email dated 22 January 2024 to the Ministry of Defence Police (MDP), which was acknowledged on 23 January 2024.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

I am writing to request the following data for the last three calendar years (2020-2023).

- The total number of vehicle accidents/ intentional damages to vehicles reported in your local car parks over the past three years.
- The total number of thefts from vehicles reported in your local car parks over the past three years.
- The total number of assaults reported in your local car parks over the past three years.

A search for information has now been completed I can confirm that MDP does hold information in scope of your request.

- The total number of vehicle accidents/ intentional damages to vehicles reported in your local car parks over the past three years.

Accidents = 14 Intentional damage = 6

- The total number of thefts from vehicles reported in your local car parks over the past three years.

Theft of vehicle = 1

Theft of item = 2

- The total number of assaults reported in your local car parks over the past three years.

Assaults = 1
