## JUDGMENT

- 1) The claimant's claim for a redundancy payment is well founded and the first respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £1785.
- 2) The claimant's complaint of a failure to provide a written statement of terms is well founded. The claimant is awarded two weeks' wages as compensation in the sum of £476, which the first respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant.
- 3) The claimant's complaint of a failure to provide itemised pay slips is also well founded.

## REASONS

Oral reasons were given at the hearing. The parties are entitled to apply for written reasons within fourteen days of the date when the judgment is sent to the parties.
