JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

- 1. The claim was issued in the South West Region Employment Tribunals on 29th July 2022. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant £178.20 gross.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £387.38.
- 4. The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £2726.20.
- 5. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £598.75.
- 6. The respondent must pay the claimant £3890.53 in total.
- 7. The claim succeeds and the remedy to which the claimant is entitled will be determined at a Remedy Hearing.
- 8. The hearing listed on **7 June 2024** is cancelled.
