- 1. The respondent has failed to file an ET3 Grounds of Resistance in this case.
- 2. Having considered the ET1, the employment Judge has decided that a determination of the claim can properly be made without a hearing and the Judgment of the Tribunal, made under rule 21 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013, is as set out below.
- 3. The respondent has unlawfully failed to pay wages to the claimant as follows:
 - 3.1 Outstanding pay for July 2023 being £56.86 (July payment due was £601.17 gross for 44hrs £10.42 and 11hours for overtime £13.02, the claimant was paid 544.31 gross)
 - 3.2 Any holiday pay for 12 days being £333.44.
- 4. The tribunal orders the respondent to pay to the claimant £ 390.30 gross (which should be paid subject to deductions for any tax and national insurance for which the respondent should account to HMRC)
