JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's claim for a statutory redundancy payment is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent shall pay the claimant the sum of £5,071.56 without deduction of Income Tax or National Insurance calculated as 13 weeks x £390.12.
- 2. The claimant's claim for unauthorised deduction from wages is dismissed as it was not presented in time when it was reasonably practicable to have done so.
- 3. The claimant's claim for unpaid holiday pay is dismissed as it was not presented in time as it was not presented in time when it was reasonably practicable to have done so.
- 4. The claimant's claim for breach of contract (failure to pay notice pay) is dismissed as it was not presented in time as it was not presented in time when it was reasonably practicable to have done so.
