Carriage of passengers to designated association football matches.

Legal Requirements

PSV operators are reminded of the terms of section 1(1) of the Sporting Events (Control of Alcohol) Act 1985, as amended by the Public Order Act 1986, which prohibits the carriage of alcohol on a PSV that is being used for the principal purpose of carrying passengers for the whole or part of a journey to or from a designated sporting event.

PSV operators are also reminded of the terms of section 2A of the Sporting Events (Control of Alcohol) Act 1985, as amended by the Public Order Act 1986, which prohibits the possession of a firework or an article or substance, whose main purpose is the emission of a flare, smoke or a visible gas, at any time during the period of,

while entering or trying to enter a designated sporting event.

A 'designated sporting event' generally means certain association football matches, whether national or international, as defined in Schedule 2 of the Sports Grounds and Sporting Events (Designation) Order 2005 (as amended). It is an offence for an operator of a PSV (or his servant or agent) to knowingly cause or permit the carriage of alcohol on journeys to which these Regulations apply.

Voluntary Guidelines on the carriage of passengers to association football matches - England and Wales

For many years the PSV industry has complied with a voluntary code of practice whereby operators taking passengers to a designated sporting event meet certain guidelines set by the police. This has worked very well, and it has seldom been necessary for a traffic commissioner to take any further action against an operator who has contravened the guidelines. Nevertheless the police in England and Wales are concerned that incidents of football related violence and disorder do still occur.

The guidelines were drafted in conjunction with the Confederation of Passenger Transport (CPT), the Crown Prosecution Service (CPS), the Coach Operators Federation (COF) and the Association of Transport Coordinating Officers (ATCO) and are set out below:

- a. PSV operators taking bookings from groups of supporters are to notify the relevant Dedicated Football Officer (DFO), at least 48 hours before the event, of the number of supporters expected to travel, the number of vehicles booked, the name and the contact number for the person who made the booking. Once available the operator must also notify the VRM and driver's name to the relevant Dedicated Football Officer.

For the purpose of these guidelines, the relevant Dedicated Football Officer means the DFO for the club that the fans are travelling to support. For example, West Ham are playing a premier league game away to Leeds United. Operator A has been contracted to transport West Ham fans from Romford and the relevant DFO is the DFO for West Ham. Operator B has been contracted to carry Leeds United fans to the game from Barrow in Furness. In this case the relevant DFO is the DFO for Leeds.

- b. Vehicles are not to stop within 10 miles of the venue either enroute to, or on departure from the event unless prior agreement is obtained from the relevant Dedicated Football Officer.
- c. Unless directed by a police officer, PSVs may stop at premises where intoxicating liquor is sold only if it is sold ancillary to a substantial meal. Prior agreement for meal stops where alcohol is available should be sought from the operator's relevant Dedicated Football Officer.
- d. PSVs are to arrive at the venue no earlier than two hours before and not later than one hour before the scheduled start of the game, unless otherwise directed by police.
- e. PSVs are not to set down or uplift passengers at any unauthorised locations without prior permission of the police.
- f. PSVs must leave the venue within 30 minutes of the finish of the event, unless directed otherwise by a police officer or ground safety officer.

- g. PSV operators are to follow all reasonable instruction given by police or enforcement officers at all times. This includes, but is not limited to, routing and stopping arrangements.
- h. Intoxicating liquor, flares and similar pyrotechnics, must not be carried on PSVs travelling to or from designated grounds. Operators will draw hirers' attention to the requirements of the law, and drivers shall, as far as reasonably practical, supervise boarding passengers and check that they are not obviously carrying intoxicating alcohol, flares and similar pyrotechnics. Drivers will not be expected to carry out baggage or body searches, nor will they be expected to confiscate alcohol or to remove passengers without police assistance. Operators may add a condition of entry to the PSV that a voluntary search may be undertaken.
- i. PSV operators are to notify the Dedicated Football Officer at the destination upon arrival at an away football ground, of any chanting demonstrating hostility based on race, ethnicity religion or beliefs, sexual orientation, disability, and transgender identity or chanting of an otherwise grossly offensive or inflammatory nature which had taken place during the journey to the ground.
- j. PSV operators are to have established safeguarding policies when carrying persons under the age of 18 years old. This is to include arrangements for the nomination of at least one responsible adult for the minors carried.

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Section 1 – Special Notices

On 1st May 2023 the West of England Combined Authority and North Somerset Council became the Bus Service Registration Authority for local bus services within the West of England and North Somerset area, using powers granted by the Transport Act 1985. The Authorities are now responsible for processing applications to register, vary or cancel local bus services that operate wholly within the West of England Combined Authority area and North Somerset. These services will not appear in the Notices and Proceedings and can be viewed at <https://travelwest.info/bus/registrations/register-of-local-bus-services-applications/>. For other services which operate cross-border, the Traffic Commissioner remains the registration authority.

Services that have been transferred to West of England Combined Authority and North Somerset Council will show as ‘Admin Cancelled’ on the gov.uk website.



Section 2 – PSV Operator Licensing

Inspection of licence applications can be requested under the provisions of Regulation 4 of the Public Service Vehicles (Operators’ Licences) Regulations 1995 by anybody who holds statutory objector status. Applications may be inspected free of charge at the Office of the Traffic Commissioner in Leeds by any person who carries written authorisation to act in that capacity.

Objections against applications for licences must be made in writing by a Chief Officer of Police or by a local authority within 21 days of the date on which notice of an application is published in Notices and Proceedings. Objections must be made on the grounds that one or more of the requirements mentioned in Sections 14(1) and (3) of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981 are not satisfied in relation to the application. A copy of the objection must be sent by the objector to the applicant at the same time that it is sent to the Traffic Commissioner. The onus of proof in terms of the grounds on which an objection is lodged lies with the objector. There is no right of objection against an application for a special licence submitted under Section 12 of the Transport Act 1985.

Classification of Operator Licences – There are four classes of licence:

- A **Standard International (SI)** licence authorises the use of any description of public service vehicle on both national and international operations;
- A **Standard National (SN)** licence authorises the use of any description of public service vehicle on national operations;
- A **Restricted licence (R)** authorises the use of:
 - a) public service vehicles not adapted to carry more than eight passengers and;
 - b) those not adapted to carry more than sixteen passengers when used otherwise than in the course of a business of carrying passengers or by a person whose main occupation is not the operation of public service vehicles adapted to carry more than eight passengers;
- A **Special Restricted (SR)** licence, issued under Section 12 of the Transport Act 1985, authorises the holder of a taxi or private hire vehicle licence to operate local services.

Appeals in connection with PSV Operator Licences must be lodged with the Upper Tribunal – Administrative Appeal Chamber (Transport), 5th Floor, Rolls Building, 7 Rolls Buildings, Fetter Lane, London, EC4A 1NL not later than one month after the date of the

letter conveying the Traffic Commissioner's (or Deputy Traffic Commissioner's) decision. Appellants can obtain guidance on lodging appeals, including downloading the appeal form, from the website: www.administrativeappeals.tribunals.gov.uk

WESTERN TRAFFIC AREA

Traffic Regulation Condition, St Ives, Cornwall with effect from 5 June 2024

Section 1 (Royal Square and Trenwith Car Park)

1.1. The following conditions shall apply to the use by vehicles operating registered local bus services of the bus stops located at

- St Ives Royal Square (OS Grid Ref. 151694, 040389 Naptan Code 800COA05255) hereafter referred to as Stop A.
- St Ives outside the Cohort on Chapel Street (OS Grid Ref. 151658, 040385 Naptan Code 0800COD40427) hereafter referred to as Stop B.
- St Ives Trewidden Road (OS Grid Ref. 151480, 040190 Naptan Code 0800COA05254) hereafter referred to as Stop C. For the purposes of these conditions the stop is considered to be regulated as a ‘Bus Stand’.

1.2. Where one or more operators seek to operate shuttle services between Trenwith Car Park and Royal Square, it shall be as part of a single shared registration as a frequent service.

1.3. Each operator will operate two vehicles as part of their responsibility to the joint registration.

1.4. Vehicles scheduled to operate services either between St Ives Rugby Club or Trenwith Car Park and Royal Square and vice-versa will be dedicated to solely operate the requirements, or any part thereof, of one individual service registration on any given day. Operators will be required to keep records of which vehicles are allocated to each service on a daily basis, including details of the start and finish times, journeys operated, drivers undertaking operation of the service and any breaks taken. These records are to be kept for a minimum of six months and made available upon request to an officer of Driver and Vehicle Services Agency, Devon & Cornwall Constabulary, Office of the Traffic Commissioner or Cornwall Council.

- 1.5. Applications for all service registrations that use either Stop A or Stop B will include a detailed route description and map.
- 1.6. Stop A will be reserved for use solely by shuttle services to and from Stop C. Passengers will both board and alight at Stop A.
- 1.7. Buses will be permitted to be on Stop A for a maximum period of 8 minutes between arrival and departure or until the arrival of the next shuttle bus, whichever is sooner.
- 1.8. Where an operator monitors compliance with 1.7 using real-time information, the 8-minute period can be exceeded by no more than 2 minutes on no more than 10% of journeys in any calendar week, Monday to Sunday. A compliance record is to be kept and provided to DVSA or OTC on request.
- 1.9. No servant or agent of an operator operating services between Trenwith Car Park and Royal Square shall be present at Royal Square for any purpose other than acting as a marshal or providing impartial advice to passengers. "Touting" for passengers for individual operators is prohibited.
- 1.10. All vehicles using Stop A shall only proceed around the island in a clockwise direction;
- 1.11. Passengers of all registered local bus services serving Royal Square, other than Trenwith – Royal Square shuttle buses, shall board and alight at Stop B only;
- 1.12. Buses will be permitted to be on Stop B only for as long as necessary for passengers to alight from and board as prescribed in points 5 and 6 above in accordance with Schedule 19, Part 1, Paragraph 3 of The Traffic Signs Regulations & General Directions 2002 (SI 2002/3113);
- 1.13. Stop C is reserved for registered local bus services operating exclusively between Trenwith Car Park and Royal Square; and Trenwith Car Park and Porthmeor Beach (Tate Gallery);
- 1.14. All services must approach Stop C from the direction of Trewidden Road subject to compliance with The County of Cornwall (St Ives) (Restrictions on Driving) (Consolidation) Order 1990;
- 1.15. At the Trewidden Road stop adjacent to Trenwith Car Park the operating procedure will be as follows;
 - 1.15.1. Buses will park in the layby in a manner which alternates operators vehicles, eg bus operator A, bus operator B, bus operator A, bus operator B, and will depart in the same order
 - 1.15.2. Buses will depart from Trenwith at intervals which, with all buses taken together, satisfy the Traffic Commissioners requirements for a frequent service.
- 1.16. In the event of passenger demand requiring more than one vehicle at any particular time at Trenwith the first and each subsequent vehicle will depart Trenwith Car Park and operate to Royal Square before returning empty to Trenwith to re-join the queue. The last vehicle used in fulfilling a peak in demand will take the place on the Royal Square to assume the next required departure back to Trenwith Car Park.
- 1.17. The reverse of the above will apply in the event of peak loadings from Royal Square to Trenwith Car Park.
- 1.18. No vehicle will be permitted to undertake a reversing manoeuvre at or in the vicinity of Stop A other than in the event of an emergency or the clockwise loop being blocked.

- 1.19. At all stops in the vicinity of Royal Square, travelling in either direction, the driver will switch off engine on arrival and not restart it until ready to depart and will be in breach of this condition if the bus is stationary for over 60 seconds with the engine running.

Section 2 (The Burrows)

- 2.1. No registered local bus service will be permitted to allow passengers to board or alight along the length the road identified as the U6014 from the junction with The Stennack to and including the roundabout forming access to Trenwith Car Park, commonly known as The Burrows.

Section 3 (Trenwith Car Park)

- 3.1. Any new operator wishing to operate within the extent of the Trenwith Car Park must seek the permission of Cornwall Council Parking Services prior to registration of any service with the Office of the Traffic Commissioner and supply evidence of same to the Traffic Commissioner when registering the service.
