Grenfell Tower site update June 2024

A summary of current activity and events at the Grenfell Tower site.

The seventh anniversary of the Grenfell Tower tragedy

- Commemorations for the seventh anniversary of the Grenfell Tower tragedy will be community-led and we are keen to support where we can.
- Grenfell Tower will be illuminated in green from 8pm on Thursday 13 June, to 6am on Friday 14 June and from 8pm to around midnight on Friday 14 June.
- We are supporting the community with access to the Grenfell Tower site over 13, 14 and 15 June. We have written to families and the immediate community separately with details of this.
- Bereaved families and survivors of the tragedy, as well as local residents, will be able to access the site on Thursday 13 June from 12pm to 7pm.
- The site will also be accessible to bereaved families and survivors only on Friday 14 June from 7.30am to 7pm and Saturday 15 June from 9am to 1pm.
- There is no need to book, but if you would prefer to book a specific time slot, you can contact us using the details at the end of this summary.
- Access to the site is off Bramley Road via Station Walk where members of the team will be there to welcome you.
- While you are visiting the site, we would be grateful if you could ensure that anyone under 18 is always accompanied by an adult.
- Families have also respectfully asked that you refrain from taking photographs within the site or sharing the details of access to the site on social media.
- Local residents may notice increased activity at the site during this time. The green lighting will also be tested during this period.

Health and wellbeing

Other updates

- Deconstruct UK Ltd (DUK), part of a wider group of companies called De-Group, has been reappointed as the principal contractor of the Grenfell Tower site.

This contract was reprocured due to government rules and guidance on spending public money. It is a standard process and is part of the government's role in keeping the tower and site secure and stable.

- DUK carries out regular maintenance and checks of the props (the metal supports installed in the tower), the hoardings around the site, and the lighting, security systems and scaffolding.
