JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

Failure to make reasonable adjustments for disability

1. The following complaint of failure to make reasonable adjustments for disability is well-founded and succeeds:

not implementing a non-permanent structure whereby the claimant's arrangement of working entirely from home is reviewed periodically, such as every 6 months.

2. The remaining complaint of failure to make reasonable adjustments for disability is not well-founded and is dismissed.

Harassment

3. The following complaint of harassment related to disability is well-founded and succeeds:

requesting and pressuring the claimant to return to working in the office on 18 May 2023.

4. The remaining complaints of harassment related to disability are not well-founded and are dismissed.
