# PRELIMINARY HEARING IN PUBLIC JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

1. The claimant's claim of unfair dismissal was not made within the time limit set out in Section 111 of the Employment Rights Act 1996. It was reasonably practicable for the claimant to have brought his claim within three months of the effective date of his termination of his employment and in the circumstances the Employment Tribunal has no jurisdiction to consider this claim.
