JUDGMENT

1. The judgment of the Tribunal is that the claimants (as named in schedule 1) complaints under section 189 of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 of a failure by the respondent to comply with the requirements of section 188 of the 1992 Act are well-founded.

2. The Tribunal awards those claimants named in schedule 1 a protective award. The Tribunal has not quantified the award as requested by The Secretary of State for Business and Trade.

3. The protective period is from 07 July 2023 and is for a period of 90 days

4. The judgment of the Tribunal is that the claimants (as named in schedule 2) complaints under section 189 of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 of a failure by the respondent to comply with the requirements of section 188 of the 1992 Act are not well-founded and are dismissed.
