ORAL JUDGMENT

The unanimous Judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- The complaint of unlawful deduction of wages and / or breach of contract in relation to non-payment of business expenses is struck out under Employment Tribunal Rule 37(1)(a) because it has no reasonable prospect of success and Rule 37(1)(c) because the claimant has not complied with the Tribunal Rules or a Tribunal order.
- 2. The application to strike out the complaint of unlawful deduction of wages in relation to the deduction of £1000 to pay Ms Saunders is refused.
- 3. The application to strike out the complaint of unlawful deduction of wages and / or breach of contract in relation to non-payment of commission for cars sold is refused.
