- a) In so far as can be determined there has been no clinical or other evidence of the following diseases on the premises of origin or the hatchery during the past 3 months: other Newcastle disease, fowl cholera, pullorum disease, avian infectious laryngotrachitis (except ducks), avian mycoplasmosis (except ducks), duck viral enteritis (only ducks and geese), duck viral hepatitis (only ducks), fowl typhoid, Marek's disease (except ducks), Salmonella enteritidis, Salmonella typhimurium, avian encephalomyelitis (except ducks), infectious bursal disease (except ducks), avian infectious bronchitis (except ducks), and Low pathogenic avian influenza (LPAI);
- b) The establishment of origin has not had a confirmed outbreak of West Nile disease during the period of at least 30 days prior to export;
