JUDGMENT

- 1. The claim for unfair dismissal is not well-founded and is dismissed.

 - insisting that the claimant undergo a medical assessment before she could return to work as referred to in emails of 14 December 2022 and 1 March 2023.
- 2. The remaining complaints of unfavourable treatment because of something arising in consequence of disability are not well-founded and are dismissed.
- 3. The complaint of failure to make reasonable adjustments for disability is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 4. Directions on remedy follow by way of a separate case management order.
