SCREENING DECISION BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER THE ELECTRICITY WORKS (ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT) (ENGLAND AND WALES) REGULATIONS 2017 ("THE 2017 REGULATIONS")

NAME OF SCHEME: JAMES FARM, WINSOR

Decision:

The Secretary of State concludes that the proposed works are not EIA development under the 2017 Regulations and do not require a statutory EIA as they are unlikely to have significant effects on the environment due to their nature, location and size. A copy of this letter has been sent to the LPA for information.

Screening decision for a proposed development ("the proposed development") to:

 Upgrade approximately 509 metres of 11kV overhead line from single phase to three phase



Secretary of State considerations:

The Secretary of State has considered the factors set out in Schedule 3 of the 2017 Regulations, together with the information within the supplied documentation ("the Application") by Southern Electric Power Distribution ("the Applicant") in relation to the impacts on the environment of the proposed development and the views of New Forest National Park Authority ("the LPA"). In particular, in reaching her decision the Secretary of State notes the following factors:

- The proposed development does not fall within Schedule 1 (mandatory EIA);
- 2. The proposed development falls under Schedule 2 of the 2017 Regulations as the electricity line is to be installed above ground in a sensitive area;
- 3. The proposed development falls within several designated sensitive areas:
 - New Forest National Park
 - A Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) Impact Risk Zone (IRZ) associated with The New Forest SSSI
- 4. The LPA was consulted regarding the proposed development and noted no objection to the development on 30 November 2022 (document reference: 22/00679).
- 5. Natural England (NE) was consulted regarding the IRZ designation. On 7 March 2024, Natural England responded with no comments regarding the development.
