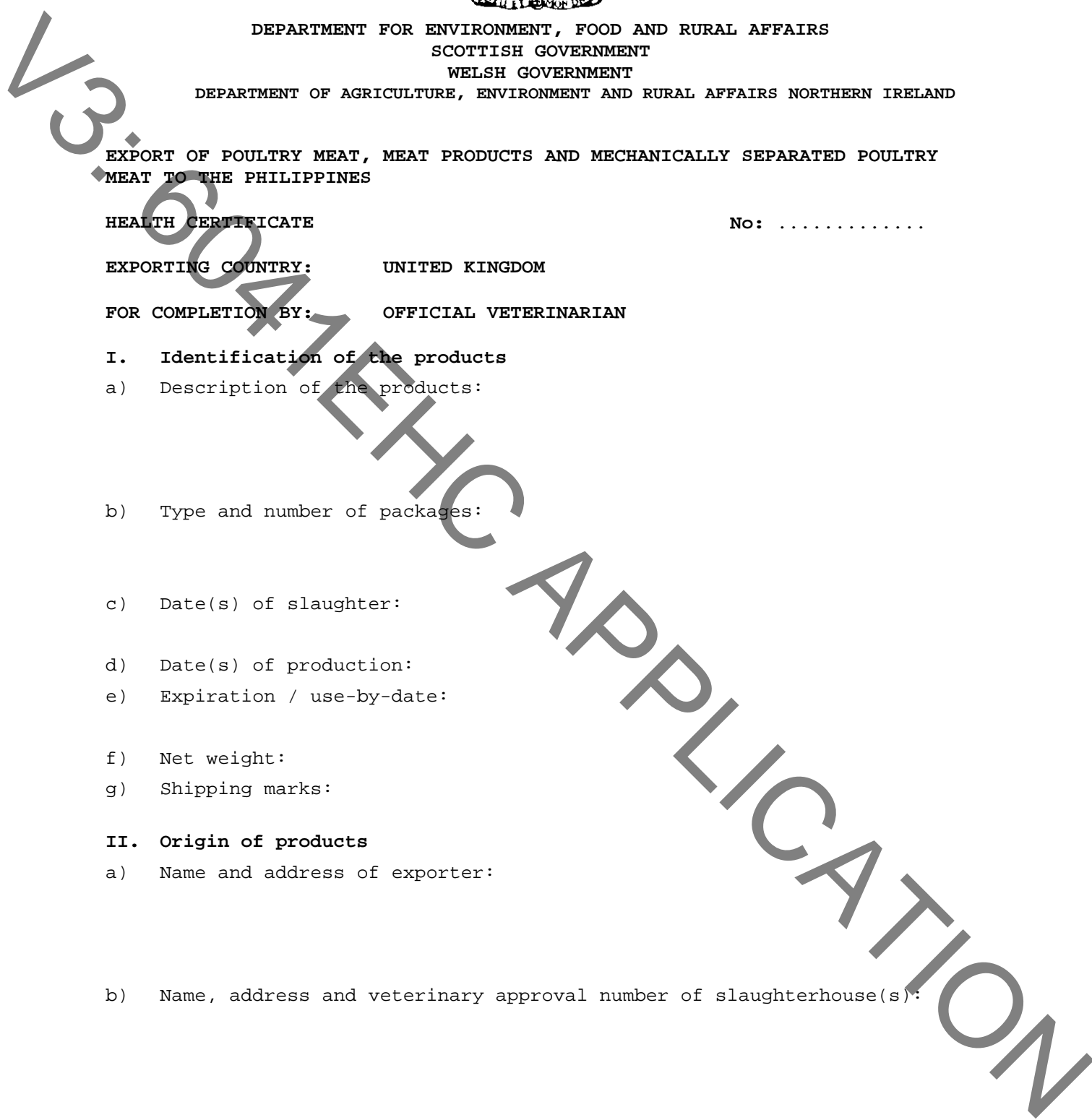

IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, certify that:

- a) The meat / product derives from animals which have undergone ante-mortem and post-mortem inspection under veterinary supervision and have been found to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease;
- b) The birds from which the poultry meat was derived originated from premises in an area which is free from **Newcastle disease** and **Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza** in poultry (poultry as defined in the WOAH Terrestrial Code);
- c) The premises in which the birds were slaughtered is in an area free from **Newcastle disease** and **Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza** in poultry (poultry as defined in the WOAH Terrestrial Code);
- d) The meat / product bears an identification mark indicating that it is fit for human consumption and was obtained from approved establishments in accordance with United Kingdom (UK) legislation laying down hygiene rules for food of animal origin and its official controls;
- e) The meat / product has been handled, wrapped and packaged, stored and transported in compliance with UK legislation so as to prevent its contamination with any agents known to cause infectious diseases of domestic animals and humans;
- f) the meat was obtained from licensed slaughterhouses which are subject to monitoring, under the UK national testing plan, for residues of veterinary medicinal products, antiparasitic agents, heavy metal contaminants, beta-agonists and substances having a thyrostatic, oestrogenic, androgenic or gestogenic action, which do not occur naturally in meat.
