SPECIFICATIONS OF THE PDO «BIERZO»

1. NAME TO PROTECT.

The geographical name to protect is «BIERZO».

2. DESCRIPTION OF THE WINE.

The wines protected by the Protected Designation of Origin "BIERZO", hereinafter, PDO "BIERZO", belong to category 1 "Wine", in accordance with the provisions of Annex VII, part II of the Regulation (EU) n° 1308/2013, of the European Parliament and of the Council, of 17 December 2013.

a) Analytical characteristics.

The analytical characteristics of the wines covered by the PDO "BIERZO" are the following:

** For first year wines, for second year and successive wines the volatile acidity may not exceed 1 gr/l of acetic acid.*

The analytical parameters not established in this document shall comply with current regulations' provisions.

b) Organoleptic characteristics.

- **White wine:**

Appearance: Clean and bright, wax yellow to golden yellow.

Aroma: Frank wines, of medium to high intensity, with fruity aromas (white fruit, stone fruit, citrus) and / or floral, (white flowers, yellow flowers). In white wines fermented or aged in barrels, in addition to the above, aromas typical of fermentation and / or aging in barrels shall appear, such as dry and / or toasted fruits and / or vanilla and / or pastry.

Taste: Fresh wines, with a medium to high body and medium to high persistence.

- **Rosé wine:**

Appearance: Clean, the colour can go from light pink to ruby red, and can also present salmon rim. Layer can vary from very low to medium.

Aroma: Clear, of medium to high aromatic intensity, with the presence of fruity aromas (red fruit, black fruit, citrus) and / or floral (white flowers, violet flowers).

Taste: Fresh sensations, medium to high body and medium to high persistence.

- **“Clarete” Wine:**

Appearance: Clean wine, whose colour varies from pale pink to ruby red, and may have a layer that goes from very low to medium.

Aroma: clear, medium to high intensity, with the presence of aromas of red and / or black fruit and / or violet flowers.

Taste: Fresh wine, of medium to high persistence, as well as medium to high body.

- **Red Wine:**

Appearance: Clean wine, medium to very high layer, with the colour ranging from purple to red.

Aroma: Frank, of medium to high aromatic intensity, with the presence of aromas of red and / or black fruit and / or violet flowers.

Taste: Fresh, structured, persistent and full-bodied wines.

- **Aged Red Wine:**

Appearance: Clean, color suitable for its category. For oak and ageing red, the colour varies from purple to red, for “Reserva” and “Gran Reserva”, the colour ranges from red to brick, presenting a medium to high layer.

Aroma: Frank, medium-high intensity, with the presence of fruity aromas (red fruit, black fruit, ripe fruit) and / or floral (violet flowers), as well as the presence of tertiary aromas typical of ageing in barrels such as vanilla, coconut, toasted, balsamic, spicy.

Taste: Fresh, structured wines with good persistence and good body.

3. OENOLOGICAL PRACTICES.

a) Cultivation practices.

To obtain the grapes used to make the wines of the PDO «BIERZO», it shall be taken into account the following:

- The vine training is to be carried out using the traditional gobelet system and its variants, or trellis training system.
- The use of irrigation in the cultivation of the vine for the production of wines with Bierzo Designation of Origin is prohibited. It shall only be allowed to irrigate the first two years in new plantations, to favour the implantation of the vines.

b) Specific oenological practices.

b.1) Wine making conditions.

- 1.- They shall be engaged in the production of wines protected by the PDO “BIERZO” exclusively consignments of healthy grapes belonging to the authorised grape varieties, with a minimum probable alcoholic strength of 12 % vol. for red varieties (except Garnacha Tintorera: 11 % vol.) and 11 % vol. for white varieties (except Godello: 12% vol.) and produced in wine-growing plots located within the delimited geographical area established in these Specifications.
- 2.- The reception of the grape consignments shall be carried out separately by grape varieties covered by the PDO.
- 3.- The reception of grapes intended for wines not covered by the PDO “BIERZO” shall be made separately from that intended for wines covered by the PDO.
- 4.- Traditional practices, applied with modern technology oriented towards improving the quality of wines, will be followed in the production of must. Appropriate pressures shall be applied for the extraction of must and wine and its separation from pomace, so that the yield does not exceed 74 litres of must or wine per 100 kilograms of harvest.

c) Restrictions on winemaking.

- 1.- For the elaboration of the wines protected by the PDO «BIERZO» these points are to be taken into account:

- Red Wine shall be made with at least 85% of the varieties Mencía, Garnacha Tintorera, Estaladiña and / or Merenzao. The other, for any of the authorized varieties.
- Rosé wine shall be made with the varieties authorized in these Specifications, with at least 70% of the red varieties.
- White wine shall be made with the varieties: Godello, Doña Blanca, Malvasía and Palomino.
- The “Clarete” wine shall be made according to the traditional way of making this type of wine in El Bierzo, for this the percentage of red grapes authorized to be used must be between 40% and 60%, the other grapes must be white grape of any of the authorized varieties. It shall be performed direct pressing, or press after a period of pre-fermentation maceration. In the alcoholic fermentation of the must, it shall be mandatory to use a percentage of between 5% and 10% of destemmed skins of white or red varieties over the total volume of the must.

2.- For the extraction of fresh grape must, or wine from fermented pomace in red processing in the process of obtaining products suitable to be covered by the PDO “BIERZO”, only mechanical systems which do not damage or dilacerate the solid components of the cluster may be used. In particular, the use of high-speed centrifugal-action crushing machines as continuous presses shall be prohibited.

4. DEMARCATION OF THE GEOGRAPHICAL AREA.

1.- The production area comprises the following municipalities, all belonging to the province of León: Arganza, Bembibre, Benuza, Berlanga del Bierzo, Borrenes, Cabañas Raras, Cacabelos, Camponaraya, Carracedelo, Carucedo, Castropodame, Congosto, Corullón, Cubillos del Sil , Fabero, Folgoso de la Ribera, Igüeña, Molinaseca, Noceda del Bierzo, Oencia, Ponferrada, Priaranza del Bierzo, Puente de Domingo Flórez, Sancedo, Sobrado, Toral de los Vados-Villadecanes, Toreno, Torre del Bierzo, Trabadelo, Vega de Espinareda and Villafranca del Bierzo.

For the new plantations carried out within the geographical area of the PDO «BIERZO» with the authorized varieties, a mandatory report from the technical services of the Regulatory Council shall be necessary, assessing the aptitude for growing the vine of the plots that are intended to be planted, regarding agroclimatic and soil characteristics previously approved by said Council.

5. MAXIMUM YIELD PER HECTARE.

1.- The maximum allowed productions per hectare are to be the following:

- **Red varieties:**

Not allowed to obtain more than:

- **Red varieties:**

- Mencía: 81.40 hectolitres per hectare.
- Garnacha Tintorera: 81.40 hectolitres per hectare.
- Estaladiña: 81.40 hectolitres per hectare.
- Merenzao: 81.40 hectolitres per hectare.

- **White varieties:**

- Doña Blanca: 81.40 hectolitres per hectare.
- Malvasía Riojana (syn. Alarije, Rojal): 81.40 hectolitres per hectare.
- Palomino: 88.80 hectolitres per hectare.
- Godello: 81.40 hectolitres per hectare.

2.- Where yields are higher than those authorised, the grapes may not be used for the production of wines protected by the PDO "BIERZO".

3.- The maximum yields per hectare set out in point 1 shall be reduced by 20% when the grapes are to be used for the production of wines using the mention of "Vino de Villa" and by 25% when they are to be used for the production of wines using the mention "Vino de Paraje". Within the wines of "paraje", they are distinguished the wine of "Viña Clasificada", whose yield will have to be 30% lower when it uses this mention, and the wine of "Gran Viña Clasificada", whose yield should be 35% lower than the maximum yield set out in point 1.

4.- Fractions of must or wine exceeding the maximum extraction yield laid down in these Specifications may not be used for the production of wines protected by the PDO "BIERZO".

6. GRAPE VARIETY OR VARIETIES.

The elaboration of the wines protected by the PDO «BIERZO» is made exclusively with grapes of the following accepted varieties:

- a) Red grape varieties: Mencía, Garnacha Tintorera, Merenzao and Estaladiña.
- b) White grape varieties: Doña Blanca (syn. Malvasía Castellana), Godello, Malvasía Riojana (syn. Alarije, Rojal) and Palomino.

7. LINK WITH THE GEOGRAPHICAL AREA.

a) Geographical area features.

a.1) Natural factors.

Relief

The PDO «BIERZO» is made up of a total of 31 municipalities, with a relief shaped and defined by a unique tectonic basin, product of the Alpine orogeny, which clearly marks the El Bierzo climatology. This relief clearly delimits the region, making the characteristics of all the municipalities that are located within the basin, in terms of relief and weather similar.

The region presents a clear but complex morphology, in which a ring of mountains with blunt and flattened shapes, interrupted by residual and isolated ridges formed by quartzites, stands out. Then a lowland area with embedded valleys that lead to deep, narrow gorges with steep slopes. Between these valleys and the peaks there are spaces of varying altitude, remains of ancient peniplains and interfluvia, with sloping shapes and landings, which make the relief more complex, but at the same time serve as links between the valleys and the mountains.

The basin, an intra-mountainous basin, is made up of sedimentary materials from the tertiary and quaternary times, furrowed by valleys that leave interfluvia with sloping shapes, slopes, isolated hills and various sets of terraces cut and deformed by erosion.

The production area, within the 31 municipalities of the PDO, is located on little slope terraces, on semi-banked slopes or on steep slopes, located between 355 and 1200 meters of altitude, although the largest area of vineyards is between the 400 and 800 meters, being able to find a vineyard in any orientation.

Soils

The predominant composition of the cultivated vine soils is the mixture of quartzites, sandstones, limestones, clays and shales.

The texture of the soil is clay-loam, favouring the contributions of water to the vine in times of greatest water needs. When the soil is dry the consistency is slightly thick.

The soils are of regular stony, not rocky. In some cases, we can find stony soils, as well as other areas where the base rock is close to the soil surface.

The colour of the dry soil is brown and wet brown-reddish. They are soils of acidic morphology, with absence of carbonates, typical of wet climates, with high water retention capacity and with a high degree of humidification inherited from the ancient tree and shrub richness, vegetation that from the phyto-graphic point of view is a contact area between the Euro-Siberian and Mediterranean regions. Their low organic matter content makes them very suitable for growing vines, favouring quality to the detriment of quantity.

The characteristics of the soils in terms of composition, texture, stoniness, morphology and other characteristics, are very similar in the 31 municipalities of the PDO, which makes them suitable for growing vineyards and obtaining quality wines.

Clima

El Bierzo region is surrounded by a mountain range that makes the climatic characteristics of the inner area common throughout them, although with some variations due to wind, altitude and orientation.

The climate of El Bierzo region is peculiar, different from that of its surroundings, since it is its own characteristic climate, defined by a mixture or transition between the oceanic climate (temperate and humid) and the continental climate (cold and dry). In this sense, we observe characteristics similar to the climate of the interior of the peninsula, but with higher minimum temperatures. El Bierzo is characterized by a mild annual average temperature, around 12.3 °C. Winters are cold, with frequent temperature inversions due to mists; summers are mild, although days with very high temperatures are not uncommon. Therefore, the thermal oscillation is very pronounced, around 16 °C, which gives the area a certain continentality.

Rainfall is relatively abundant, although unevenly distributed. The average annual rainfall of El Bierzo vineyards varies, the average amount being 793 mm. The months of October, November and December are the rainiest, and the driest are June, July and August.

Observing these data, we can say that the climate in El Bierzo has characteristics similar to those of the inland climate if we take into account continentality, but with higher minimum temperatures and with more abundant rainfall than the so-called dry Spain. In fact, the peculiar ombro-thermic diagram that El Bierzo region presents year after year, shows its unique characteristics, climatically speaking.

Another determining factor as a fundamental parameter in the grapes ripening of quality is the important number of hours of sunshine per year and more specifically in the summer season, exceeding 300 hours of sunshine on average during the months of July and August, exceptional data for the latitude and longitude in which El Bierzo region is, and its Atlantic influence within the Northwest of Spain.

For all this we can say that the climatic characteristics of the municipalities covered by the Designation make them very suitable for growing grapes and obtaining quality grapes.

a.2) Human factors

1.- The development of vineyard cultivation in El Bierzo has been linked for centuries to people. Two types of locals stand out in successive times; the peasants who cultivated their own vineyards (very few) or for the feudal lords who owned them (the vast majority); and the monks belonging to the different orders settled in the 25 monasteries existing in the Region before the fiscal reform.

2.- The transfer of knowledge of vine cultivation and learning for generations among the inhabitants of El Bierzo, has shaped the evolution of vineyard cultivation in El Bierzo to this day. Thus, the plantation frameworks in the existing old vineyards (more than 85% at the 31 municipalities) are influenced by the not so old practice of tilling the vines with animal power; as well as the slopes, mostly and sometimes steep, which even today do not allow any other mechanized tillage option.

3.- The peasants and monks have selected for centuries and formed the indigenous varieties rooted in El Bierzo, such as Mencía, Garnacha Tintorera, Godello, Doña Blanca, Palomino and Malvasía; traditional indigenous varieties in El Bierzo. One of the main characteristics of the PDO «BIERZO» is the age of our vineyard, specifically the average age is around 75 years. In these plantations, mainly of the Mencía variety (75%), we find

other minority varieties such as Estaladiña, Merenzao, Negreda, and others, in all the municipalities of the PDO.

Within this wide range we find, in addition to the traditional varieties accepted up to now by the Designation of Origin, others such as Merenzao and Estaladiña. These varieties must be recognized, otherwise they would appear destined to disappear, and therefore the viti-cultural heritage of local varieties well adapted to the environment and of oenological interest would be lost.

b) Product details.

The qualities of the Bierzo wines are mainly due to the slow ripening of the grapes, which makes the concentration of polyphenols high and our wines have an attractive colour, as well as the aromatic substances in the skin of the grape that makes that our wines are very fresh, highlighting their subtle acidity, associated with the varietal identity and geographical environment.

c) Description of the causal link.

The wines of the protected area owe their typicity mainly linked to the geographical environment: the soil, geological and climatic characteristics of our region, make it an exceptional area for vine growing. All the municipalities have similar characteristics, so the latter can be considered suitable for the production of quality wines. In addition, farmers have selected the most suitable and best adapted varieties to the environment in which they are developed, since they are indigenous varieties, which can be found in all the municipalities that are part of the Designation. The cultivation methods are the most suitable and allow to obtain a singular and different product, since we are talking about vineyard plots planted from the end of the 19th century and beginning of the 20th century, with the same varieties, same rootstocks, planting frames and similar production systems.

The main circumstances that prove this link are summarized below:

- The clay-loam soils, with a greater or lesser amount of thick elements such as slates and quartzites, shall bring elegance and finesse to the wines, which shall make them easily distinguishable from wines from other areas.
- The microclimate of the region is different from that of the surrounding areas that are located outside the mountain range, since we have a strong Atlantic influence that causes the region to have abundant rainfall and a mild annual average temperature, along with a certain continentality due to the strong thermal oscillation that shall favor the ripening of the grape.

- We find the vineyards on slopes of greater or less gradient and whose altitude varies, and we can find vines at an altitude of more than 1000 m above sea level, so the wines are going to be very fresh and lively.
- The varieties that we find in El Bierzo are perfectly adapted to the environment. Mostly we find the Mencía and the Godello varieties, although to a lesser extent we find the other authorized varieties. Our red wines are wines with a great fruit expression, fresh and with great ageing capacity in barrels. White wines are fresh, tasty and with volume in the mouth, making them unmistakable.
- The planting frames that have been traditionally used are narrow planting frames, which together with the characteristics of the soils means that grape productions are not very high and grape of a high quality is produced, with balanced analytical parameters and a good maturation.
- The age of the vineyard in the area gives the wines of the area is an added value, since the average age of the Bierzo vineyard is around 75 years, old vineyards being 85% of the vine surface. It must be taken into account that the quality of the grapes produced by the old vines is very high since, over the years, there is a balance between the means of production of the vine and its harvest, making the maturation optimize. The powerful and deep root system shall explore a greater volume of soil, ensuring mineral nutrition, as well as greater availability of water, making plants less sensitive to climatic variations each year, ensuring constant ripening throughout of the years. Also, the greater volume of old wood accumulates a greater quantity of reserves than mobilized towards the bunches, they contribute to maintaining the quality in the successive harvests. In addition, the old vines have a large number of scars produced by pruning wounds, which hinder the flow of the sap through the conducting vessels, making them develop fewer bunches, and these shall be smaller and thanks to these flow difficulties tend to produce a greater accumulation of sugars and other quality compounds in the grape.
- In short, the different microclimate of the area, a mix between the Atlantic and the continental climate, together with the soils, the predominance of old vineyards and the high density of plantation that shall give low productions with very good ripening, will contribute to obtain wines with plenty of fresh fruit, balanced and with good acidity.

8. OTHER APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS.

a) Legal framework.

- Order of December 11, 1989 from the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, which approves the Regulations for the Bierzo Designation of Origin and its Regulatory Council.

b) Other additional requirements.

In order for the wines to be covered by the PDO “BIERZO”, they must be produced, stored, aged, where appropriate, and bottled and labelled in wineries located within the delimited geographical area indicated in these Specifications.

b.1) Exceptions to the application of maximum yields.

The maximum production limits in kilograms per hectare established in section 5 of these Specifications may be modified in certain campaigns, prior to the harvest and in accordance with current legislation. In any case, the maximum increase that may be authorized may not exceed 15 percent of the limits referred to above.

b.2) Provisions regarding packaging and bottling.

1.- The winemaking process includes the bottling and ageing operations of the wines, in such a way that the organoleptic and physical-chemical characteristics described in these Specifications can only be guaranteed if all of the wine handling operations takes place in the production area. Consequently, in order to safeguard quality, guarantee the origin and ensure control, taking into account that the bottling of the wines covered by the PDO «BIERZO» is one of the critical points for achieving the characteristics defined in these Specifications, such operation shall be carried out in the wineries located in the bottling facilities within the production area.

2.- The wines covered by the PDO «BIERZO» can only circulate and be issued by the wineries located in the defined geographical area, in the types of packaging that do not harm their quality or prestige, and that guarantee the preservation of the physical-chemical and organoleptic characteristics of the product, established in section 2 of these Specifications.

b.3) Provisions regarding labelling.

1.- On the labels of bottled wines, the geographical name «BIERZO» and the traditional term «Designation of Origin» shall appear as mandatory indications, and prominently, accompanying the geographical name, replacing the Protected Designation of Origin (PDO) , along with the other mandatory mentions that are determined in the specific rules and regulations, as well as in the applicable general legislation.

2.- The indication of the "vintage" shall also be mandatory, even if the wine has not undergone ageing processes.

3.- In addition, the wines covered by the DOP «BIERZO» may make use of the optional indications on the labeling that are listed in the following sections:

- The traditional terms “crianza”, “reserva” and “gran reserva”, under the conditions laid down in the specific rules and regulations, as well as in the applicable legislation.
- The terms “fermentado en barrica” (fermented in barrels), “criado en barrica” or “envejecido en barrica” (barrel-aged), provided that they comply with the conditions of use laid down in current legislation in force.
- In application of Article 120, paragraph 1, letter g) of Regulation (EU) No. 1308/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of December 17, 2013, the name of a smaller geographical unit (geographic name) together with the following mentions, as long as they comply with the conditions that are also indicated:

• **Vino de Villa** followed by the geographical name of a municipality or villa of those included in the defined geographical area and which appear in the following table, as long as the protected wine has been made with 100% grapes from plots located in that municipality or villa, in addition to comply with the yield limitation indicated in point 3 of section 5 of these Specifications.

In addition, those wines that make use of the **Vino de Paraje** mention may complete this indication relative to a smaller geographical unit with the following indications, provided that the conditions, also established, are met:

- **Viña Clasificada**, following or accompanying the geographical name of the smaller geographical unit, when the wine has been made with 100% grapes from a single plot or from several neighboring ones, located in the same cartographically delimited *paraje*, with identification of the plots that make it make up and that, for at least five years, have made use of the indication *Vino de Paraje*, in addition to complying with the yield limitation indicated in point 3 of section 5 of these Specifications. Prior to marketing, these wines must have been valued by the Regulatory Council.
- **Gran Viña Clasificada**, following or accompanying the geographical name of the smaller geographical unit, when the wine has been made with 100% grapes from a single plot or from several neighboring ones, located in the same cartographically defined *paraje*, with identification of the plots that make it up and that, for at least five years, have made use of the *Viña Clasificada* indication, in addition to complying with the yield limitation indicated in point 3 of section 5 of these Specifications. Prior to marketing, these wines must have been valued by the Regulatory Council.

9. VERIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE SPECIFICATIONS.

a) Control Body.

b.2) Control tasks.

b.1) Scope of the controls.

The annual verification referred to in Article 90, section 3, of Regulation (EU) 1306/2013, shall consist of the following:

- An organoleptic and analytical examination of the wines received from the PDO «BIERZO».
- A control of compliance with the other conditions established in the Specifications.

b.2) Methodology of controls.

1.- The Control Body shall establish a Control Plan every year in which the different control tasks shall be defined, aimed at verifying compliance with the provisions of these Specifications, their nature and frequency, all without prejudice to the controls derived from the existence of signs of irregularity.

The Control Plan shall include the following actions:

- On-site control at the operators' facilities to ensure that they are truly capable of meeting the conditions set out in the Specifications.
- Control of the products in any phase of the production process and in the packaging phase, when appropriate, based on an inspection plan that covers all the product production phases and of which the operators have been informed.

2.- For each of these activities, the Control Body shall define in each Plan the number of units to control (sample size), guaranteeing representativeness with respect to the control universe, as well as the criteria to be applied to make the selection of the sample, which shall be carried out by one or more of the following methods:

- i. random controls based on a risk analysis,
- ii. sampling,
- iii. systematic checks.

3.- The annual check shall guarantee that a product can only use the PDO «BIERZO» if:

- a) The results of the organoleptic and analytical examinations of the wines demonstrate that they meet the requirements of the Specifications and have all the appropriate characteristics of the protected designation of origin.
- b) the controls carried out confirm the compliance with the other conditions listed in the Specifications.
