JUDGMENT

- 1. The complaint of constructive unfair dismissal is upheld.
- 2. The complaint of unlawful deduction from wages is dismissed.
- 3. The claimant is awarded compensation in the sum of £22,834.98 comprising:
 - (a) a basic award of £3,426
 - (b) a compensatory award of £19,408.98, which includes a 20% uplift for failure to comply with the ACAS Code of Practice.
- 4. The recoupment provisions do not apply.
