JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that:-

1. The claimant's claim for a statutory redundancy payment is well founded and succeeds.
2. The claimant's claim for unpaid holiday pay is well founded and succeeds.
3. The claimant's claim for unpaid wages is well founded and succeeds.

REMEDY

The Judgement of the Employment Tribunal on remedy is that:

1. The respondent shall pay to the claimant the total gross sum of **£3,068.55**.
2. The has been calculated in the following way:
 - a. A Statutory Redundancy Payment of **£2,707.65**.
 - b. Unpaid wages: 2 days @ £120.30 per day = **£240.60**.
 - c. Unpaid holiday pay: 1 day @ £120.30 = **£120.30**.
