JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that:-

- 1. The claimant's claim for a statutory redundancy payment is well founded and succeeds.
- 2. The claimant's claim for unpaid holiday pay is well founded and succeeds.
- 3. The claimant's claim for unpaid wages is well founded and succeeds.

REMEDY

The Judgement of the Employment Tribunal on remedy is that:

- 1. The respondent shall pay to the claimant the total gross sum of £3,068.55.
- 2. The has been calculated in the following way:
 - a. A Statutory Redundancy Payment of £2,707.65.
 - b. Unpaid wages: 2 days @ £120.30 per day = **£240.60**.
 - c. Unpaid holiday pay: 1 day @ £120.30 = **£120.30**.
