



Application to register temporary use of land or buildings to keep livestock

Use this form to apply for a new temporary land association (TLA) or temporary country parish holding (tCPH) number.

If you have previously applied for this land under a TLA, you do not need to complete a new form. Call APHA to reactivate.

You cannot apply for a TLA or tCPH for cattle with movement restrictions, for example, if a TB test is overdue, until the restriction is lifted.

How to complete this form

Use one copy of this form to apply for either:

- one or more TLAs (complete all sections apart from section 5)
- one tCPH (complete all sections)

What happens next

APHA aims to process applications within 10 working days. It may take longer if:

- your application is inaccurate
- the form is incomplete
- APHA need to carry out a bovine TB veterinary risk assessment

Section 1: Application type

1.1 You must complete this section so APHA can process your application.

* Application Type: **temporary land association (TLA)** **temporary CPH (tCPH)**

1.2 Enter the date you want the TLA(s) or tCPH to start. This must be:

- the date you intend to move animals onto the land or into the building, as agreed with whoever currently has control of the land
- at least 10 days from the date you send an application to APHA
- a weekday

If you want your registration to start as soon as we are able to process your application, put 'ASAP' rather than a date in the start date box.

Section 3: Land holder details

If you are applying for a set of TLAs or a tCPH with fields or buildings involving more than one landowner or CPH number, you must complete a separate section 3 and 4 for each CPH number. You'll need to either:

- print out a blank copy of the sections and fill them out by hand
- download extra copies of this form and complete sections 3 and 4 to include in your application

3.1 You must complete this section with the details of the person whose land or buildings you have agreed to use. The terms 'renting' and 'rent' refer to any arrangement between yourself and someone else for you to use land they have control of.

How to a find a parcel ID (for fields only)

You will need to speak with the person whose field you have agreed to use to provide the parcel ID. The parcel ID is a unique 10 character ID number given to a land parcel when it is registered on the Rural Payments service (for example, ST 6789 6789).

Section 5: tCPH location details (only to be completed for tCPH applications)

5.1 Enter the location of the main area you will keep livestock ('gathering point') for the group of fields or buildings in section 4. You'll need either a:

- 12-character OS map reference (for example, SO 12345 12345)
- 10 character parcel ID (for example, ST 6789 6789), as provided by the person whose field you have agreed to use

- if any of the details supplied in this form change, I will inform APHA as soon as possible

- I will not mix my livestock with anyone else's livestock
- I will prevent nose-to-nose contact between my cattle and anyone else's livestock if TB restrictions are in force on my cattle, at the time of this application
- I will contact APHA if I stop using this land to keep livestock before the planned end date.
