Teresa and her teams lead on offshore environmental regulation for oil and gas activities on the UKCS. In particular her teams deal with:

- International and domestic offshore environmental policy;
- Inspection of platforms and drilling rigs;
- Assessment of environmental impacts of oil and gas projects;
- Assessment of oil spill contingency plans – including financial provision for remediation in the event of an accident/incident;
- Emergency response to offshore environmental incidents (24/7 on call provision);
- Assessment of oil and gas platform and pipeline decommissioning plans;
- Consideration of legal obligations and financial security for decommissioning of offshore installations and pipelines; and Strategic Environmental Assessments (SEAs) of UK continental shelf prior to licensing
