**Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 - Rule 21**

1. The claimant's complaints under section 189 of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 of a failure by the respondent to comply with the requirements of section 188 of the 1992 Act is not well-founded.
