JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

1. The claimant's complaints under section 189 of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 of a failure by the respondent to comply with the requirements of section 188 of the 1992 Act is not well-founded. This is because the claimant was based at Manchester in an establishment where less than 20 staff were made redundant and accordingly the claimant is not entitled to a protective award.
