JUDGMENT

- (1) The claim for redundancy pay succeeds in a sum to be decided.

REASONS

- (1) The claim was issued in the London Central Employment Tribunals on 17 April 2024. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- (2) The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's redundancy pay.
- (3) The claimant is requested to provide a calculation of his redundancy pay with supporting evidence **within 7 days**.
- (4) The hearing listed on **25 July 2024** will be converted to a remedy hearing. This hearing may not be required if a judge is satisfied that he can make a decision based on the papers.
- (5) Claim for unlawful deduction from wages is brought out of time and is dismissed.
