JUDGMENT

All claims are struck out as they have not been actively pursued and the Claimant has not complied with the Orders of the Tribunal made on 14 December 2023.

REASONS

1. In a letter of 12 March 2024, the Tribunal - as instructed by Employment Judge Rice- Birchall - warned the Claimant that it was considering striking out her claim on the bases that:
 - a. She not complied with the Orders of the Tribunal made on 14 December 2023 and sent to you on 15 December 2023; and
 - b. That it had not been actively pursued.
2. The letter gave the Claimant 14 days, from its own date, to object to the proposal, giving reasons in writing or to request a hearing at which she could set out such reasons.
3. As at today, 8 July 2024, the Claimant has not responded.
