Thank you for your request for information dated 04 January 2024. Please find our response to each of your questions below:

Q1. Did redacted section 5 seek any 'discussion, clarification or justification' from BioNTech?

As described in our response to FOI 24/013 (sent on 31 January 2024), item 5 was redacted because it was not relevant to the question you asked in FOI 23/421. We confirm that this section did not seek any discussion, clarification or justification from BioNTech.

Q2. Please provide a copy of the Minutes of the meeting at which this committee discussed the responses provided by BioNTech to any of the matters raised under items 3, 4 or 5

Please refer to our response to FOI 24/013 (sent on 31 January 2024). All major objections/issues were considered to be adequately resolved at the CHM meeting on 30 November 2020. Therefore, the CHM recommended approval of the Pfizer/BioNTech Covid-19 vaccine under Regulation 174. Please find the Summary Minutes for this meeting attached.
