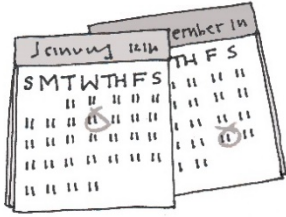




Inspection of HMP Full Sutton



Inspectors visited this prison in March 2024.



We wanted to find out if things were better, the same or worse for prisoners since we last visited in 2020.



We did this by:

- looking around the prison
- asking prisoners and staff to fill in a questionnaire
- speaking to prisoners
- speaking to staff and helpers
- reading documents.

What did we find?



Prisoners felt quite safe. The prison needed to be more careful about using force on prisoners.
We gave the prison 3 out of 4 for this.



Prisoners got some good support from staff. Prisoners' ideas about how to make Full Sutton better were not used very well.
We gave the prison 3 out of 4 for this.



Prisoners did not get enough time in education and work. They did not get enough time out of their cells or outside.
We gave the prison 2 out of 4 for this.



Prisoners got good support to help them work through their sentence plan.
We gave the prison 3 out of 4 for this.

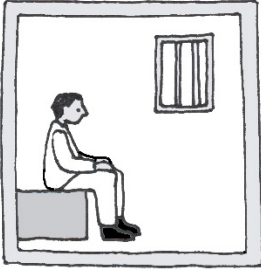
What should the prison do?



We want the governor to read our inspection report. You can find the report in the prison library.

We want the governor to make a plan. The plan should tell us how they will fix the problems at HMP Full Sutton and make things better for prisoners.

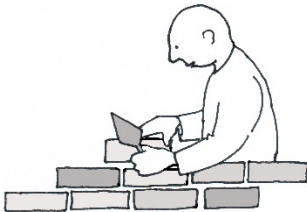
What do we want to happen?



We want prisoners to be separated for less time. We want them to have more to do when they are separated.



We want prisoners to get the mental health support they need.



We want prisoners have more time out of their cells. We want them to be able to go to education and work for the whole day.



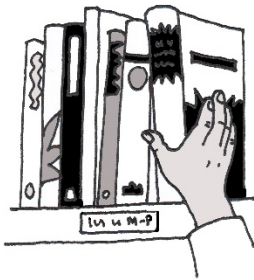
We want prison staff to only use force when they have to. We want them to use force safely.



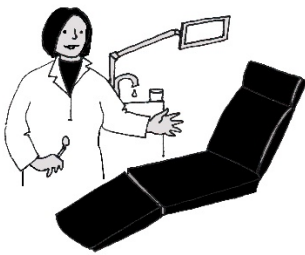
We want prisoners to get more time outside.

We want there to be more books and DVDs in the library in other languages.



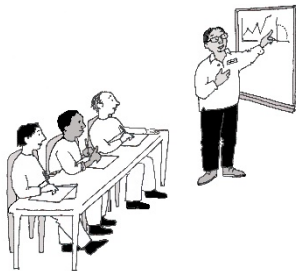
We want prisoners to be able to see the dentist more quickly.



We want prisoners to get good, safe health care. We want medicine to be given out safely.

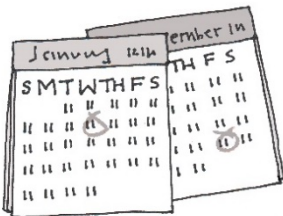


We want prisoners to get better careers information and advice. We want them to be able to do prison jobs that help them to get the skills they need.

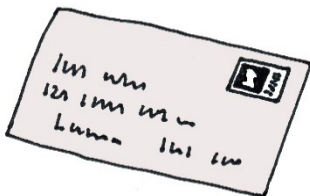


We want prisoners to be able to start education courses like English and maths more quickly.
