- 4. Is this data available by financial year? If so, I would be grateful for the number of applications for each of the following financial years 2014/15, 2015/16, 2016/17, 2017/18, 2018/19, 2019/20, 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23, 2023/24?
- 5. How many pre-submission meetings MHRA have held with interested parties wishing to discuss their full EAMS application between April 2014 to March 2024?
- 6. Is this data available by financial year? If so, I would be grateful for the number for each of the following financial years 2014/15, 2015/16, 2016/17, 2017/18, 2018/19, 2019/20, 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23, 2023/24?
- 7. How many of the current and expired scientific opinions were completed within the 75 day procedure?

We have dealt with your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

We confirm that we hold the information you have asked for; however, we consider that the information is exempt from disclosure because Section 12 of the FOIA applies.

Section 12 allows public authorities to refuse requests where the cost of dealing with them would exceed the "appropriate limit" in the FOIA; for central government departments this is set at £600. This represents the estimated cost of one person spending 24 working hours to determine if the requested information is held, and then to locate, retrieve and extract it.

We will explain how compliance with your request would exceed the appropriate limit and why Section 12 applies in this case.

There have been 171 applications received for EAMs between April 2014 and November 2023. In order to comply with your request in its entirety, we would need to look at each application and ascertain how many applications would be relevant to each of your questions. In addition, we would need to look at each application individually to see how many applications, for example, were completed within the procedure timelines you have stipulated. This would take approximately 30-45 minutes per application. For this reason, we calculate that this would take us over the 24 working hours stipulated in the FOIA.



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When Section 12 of the FOIA applies, we also provide advice to assist you in making a new, narrowed request for a smaller amount of information. In this case, we advise that you could narrow your request by focusing on a smaller subset of applications received that you would like specific information for. Please note that other sections of the FOIA may also apply to future requests, for example, Section 22 may apply to some data for EAMs applications received from November 2023 to April 2024, as these will be published in future updates to the EAMs information on the MHRA website and future Annual Reports.
