 - i) I reasonably believe the animal to be over six months of age;

ii) I confirm that the age, breed, sex, and description of the animal is true and correct, and matches the information documented on the animal's rabies vaccination certificate/record;

iii) I reasonably believe, that at the time of examination, the animal appears to be healthy and free of infectious or contagious diseases, and to the best of my knowledge and belief, has not been exposed to any infectious or contagious diseases in the past 30 days that would endanger the health of humans or other animals;

- 3) To the best of my knowledge and belief, the animal has not been in a dog-mediated rabies virus variant (DMRVV) high-risk country or in an area under quarantine for rabies and has not been exposed to rabies in the past 6 months;
- 4) To the best of my knowledge and belief, the dog identified in Paragraph I, has:

i)* either resided continuously in the United Kingdom for the six months immediately preceding export;

ii)* or, been continuously resident in the United Kingdom and in any other countries that are dog rabies-free or low-risk in the six months immediately preceding export;

and,

iii) has not been in an area under quarantine for rabies and has not been exposed to rabies in the past 6 months;
