JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

1. The claim was issued in the London South Employment Tribunals on 14 May 2024. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant £3,300 gross.
3. The respondent must pay the claimant **£3,300** in total.
4. The claimant must account to HMRC for any sums he owes it in respect of any sums received from the respondent pursuant to this judgment.
