



Inspection of HMP & YOI Hollesley Bay



Inspectors visited this prison in April 2024.



We wanted to find out if things were better, the same or worse for prisoners since we last visited in 2018.



We did this by:

- looking around the prison
- asking prisoners and staff to fill in a questionnaire
- speaking to prisoners
- speaking to staff and helpers
- reading documents.

What did we find?



Prisoners felt safe.

We gave the prison 4 out of 4 for this.



The prison was clean and tidy, and most prisoners had their own rooms. Most staff were friendly.

We gave the prison 4 out of 4 for this.



Education and workshops were mostly good. Prisoners did not have enough to do in the evenings or at weekends.

We gave the prison 3 out of 4 for this.



Prisoners got good help to get ready to leave the prison.

We gave the prison 4 out of 4 for this.

What should the prison do?



We want the governor to read our inspection report. You can find the report in the prison library.

We want the governor to make a plan. The plan should tell us how they will fix any problems at HMP & YOI Hollesley Bay and make things better for prisoners.

What do we want to happen?



We want all staff to treat prisoners well. We want them to be friendly and helpful.



We want the food to be better. We want prisoners to get enough to eat at mealtimes.



We want prisoners to be able to get health care appointments more quickly.



We want prisoners with long-term health conditions to have a care plan. The plan should say how they will be looked after.



We want the prisoners to get maths and English qualifications.




We want there to be more for prisoners to do in the evenings and at weekends.



We want community probation teams to contact prisoners when they are supposed to.

What will we do?
