JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

- 1. The claim was issued in the London South Employment Tribunals on 23 January 2024. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant £2,930.46 gross.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £3,246.16 gross as the claimant worked for the respondent for 4 years and is therefore entitled to 4 weeks' notice.
- 4. The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £3,858. This has been calculated as follows: the claimant was 49 years old when he was made redundant and had worked for the respondent for 4 years at the time of his dismissal. He is therefore entitled to £3,858 gross.
- 5. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £1,281.20 gross.
- 6. The respondent must pay the claimant £11,315.82 in total.
- 7. The hearing listed on **16 August 2024 is** vacated.
- 8. The claimant must account to HMRC for any sums he owes it in respect of any sums received from the respondent pursuant to this judgement.
