of references to standards relating to gas appliances in support of Regulation (EU) 2016/426 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 March 2016 on appliances burning gaseous fuels and repealing Directive 2009/142/EC, as it has effect in domestic law (Regulation 2016/426)

1. This notice sets out proposals that the references to standards listed in Annex I to this notice are published for the purposes of Article 6A of Regulation (EU) 2016/426, as it has effect in domestic law and accordingly are designated pursuant to that regulation in relation to England and Wales and Scotland.

The references to the standards are proposed to be published and accordingly designated under Article 6A of Regulation 2016/426 at 00.01 on the 29th day beginning with the date of this notice, unless this notice is withdrawn or amended before that date.
